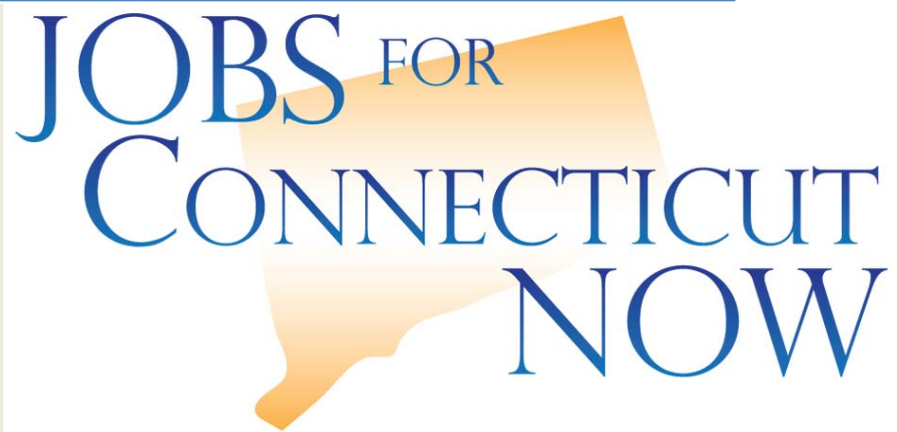

## **I. Introduction**

Gaining a better sense of our leaders allows us to better gauge who we believe will best represent us in the state legislature. The voting records of our elected officials serve as a key tool in this assessment.

Throughout the legislative process from a bill's introduction in committee through the final voting of the full legislative body, we can see how our members have voted on our behalf.

The following pieces of legislation ranging from development zones to agency permitting are bills of particular interest to the business community in Connecticut.

Whether a bill was passed into law, "died" in committee or on the floor, or ultimately was vetoed by the Governor, each bill would have an effect on job creation, infrastructure and economic growth.

This collection of bills from the 2009 and 2010 legislative session seeks to give such an overview:

## **VOTE SCORING & FINAL TABULATION**

Of the total 14 bills reviewed in this scorecard, only 12 received full floor votes from both the House and Senate.

In order to ensure the fairest methodology of scoring the percentages were based on the 12 bills which received full floor votes where every member had the opportunity to be counted.

Favorable = 1 point

Unfavorable = 0 points

Absent / Not Voting = 0 points

Total points were based on the number of votes cast by the legislator then averaged and a percentage and corresponding grade letter assigned.

## **II. Bill Summaries ~ 2009**

### **PASSED**

#### **House Bill 6600: An Act Concerning the Establishment of the Sustinet Plan**

In its final version, this legislation established an 11 member Sustinet Health Partnership board of directors to study and make legislative recommendations, by January 1, 2011, on the details and implementation of the “Sustinet Plan,” a self-insured health care delivery plan. The Sustinet plan would create a state sponsored insurance plan that would offer a benefit package similar to those offered by an employer. Small businesses and non-profits would be among those who would enroll first. Enrollment in the plan was to be voluntary. Those who receive their health services through state programs such as Medicaid, Husky A and B and SAGA would be included in the plan.

A hotly debated topic, aimed at addressing a failing healthcare system it was seen by some as the wrong time for Connecticut to be implementing an overwhelmingly expensive new government program estimated to cost \$1 billion when the state and tax payers were already facing increasing budget deficits.

**Final Outcome:** Governor Rell’s veto was overridden by the House and Senate in a special session in July of 2009.



## **PASSED**

**House Bill 6802:** An Act Concerning Expenditures and Revenue for the Biennium Ending June 30, 2011 (BUDGET)

After months of negotiations a budget agreement was finally reached in September of 2009.

The omnibus bill included increases in personal income, corporation, cigarette and tobacco products taxes and extended the real estate conveyance tax to property foreclosed by sale. It also transferred funds from the “Rainy Day” Fund to General Fund revenue for fiscal year 2010 and fiscal year 2011 and increased various state fees.

Perceived as relying too heavily on one time revenue generators and bonding, some were concerned that the state would find itself in an even tougher economic situation in the upcoming fiscal years 2010-2011. An additional setback for the state’s economy was the inability for the state to implement the planned reduction in the state sales tax from 6 % to 5.5%.

**Final Outcome:** Passed by the legislature, the Governor allowed the budget to become law without her signature.



## **Bill Summaries ~ 2010**

### **PASSED**

#### **Senate Bill 107: An Act Establishing a Bradley Development Zone**

This legislation creates a development zone around Bradley International Airport and extends enterprise zone property tax exemptions and corporation business tax credits to manufacturers and other specified businesses that develop or acquire property in the zone.

The bill seeks to revive the area by attracting new manufacturing and business facilities to locate in the distressed towns of the development zone through the offering of a variety of financial incentives. It creates a new creative tool for development and to attract private capital back to the state.

**Final Outcome:** The bill was passed by both the House and the Senate by large margins. There was bipartisan support for passage and the bill was signed into law by the Governor.



## **PASSED**

### **Senate Bill 261:** An Act Concerning the Connecticut Jobs Corps Task Force

Planning for construction and trades jobs and providing workers with good benefits, the bill establishes a State Jobs Corps Task Force to study how the state may, under federal and state law, implement a program similar to the Works Progress Administration (WPA), to use unemployed workers to construct public works projects in the state.

By evaluating the WPA program the state could find potential tactics to address the problems in the state's current economic climate. An innovative state program to plan for integrating Federal stimulus funds and state money.

**Final Outcome:** Passed unanimously by the House and Senate the Governor signed the bill as a "Special Act".



## **PASSED**

**Senate Bill 494:** An Act Making Adjustments to State Expenditures for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2011.

Facing continued shortfalls for the upcoming fiscal year the general assembly adopted revisions to the budget passed in September of 2009.

Revisions to the budget include the transfer of monies from various special funds to the General Fund and move unappropriated general fund surplus from fiscal year 2010 to the General Fund as income for fiscal year 20 11. It also permits the state to issue revenue bonds supported by two charges on electric company bills to contribute \$956 million to the General Fund.

**Final Outcome:** The legislation was passed on the final day of the 2010 regular session and signed by the Governor.



## **PASSED**

**House Bill 5208:** An Act Concerning the Permit and Regulatory Authority of the Department of Environmental Protection and Establishing an Office of the Permit Ombudsman Within the Department of Economic and Community Development

This legislation seeks to make it easier for business in Connecticut to work with the Department of Environmental Protection and in turn foster increased economic development.

By making several changes to the process and practice for issuing regulatory permits and adopting regulatory requirements and standards the legislation requires faster permitting for economic development projects that need environmental, public health, and transportation permits. It is a major policy change to stop and control DEP anti-business regulatory operations.

These faster processes will be coordinated by a newly established permit ombudsman office. A more efficient department will translate to better opportunities for businesses to navigate the state's programs and boost the economy.

**Final Outcome:** The bill was passed by unanimously by the Senate and the House passed it with only one legislator voting against it. The bill was signed by Governor Rell in June.



## **PASSED**

### **House Bill 5383:** An Act Concerning Regional Economic Development

House Bill 5383 provides for the formation of regional economic development districts, allowing a region to apply for state and federal economic development funds for brownfields redevelopment. By cleaning up and revitalizing once useless blighted areas, there is a greater potential to attract new businesses to locate in those areas and spurring new job growth.

The bill is a job creator and an innovative policy to create new development opportunities in neglected areas of the state.

**Final Outcome:** The Governor signed the bill into law which had been passed unanimously by the House Chamber and was placed on the “consent calendar” by the Senate and passed unanimously without requiring a formal roll call vote.



## **PASSED**

### **House Bill 5435: An Act Concerning the Recommendations of the Majority Leaders' Job Growth Roundtable**

This omnibus bill addresses a number of policy changes in order to grow Connecticut jobs and expand business opportunities.

Among its many provisions this legislation: Authorizes programs and policies for establishing or expanding businesses and creating jobs; Authorizes up to \$5 million in bonds for developing new business concepts; Authorizes credits for investing in technology-based start-up businesses and expanding businesses, including those using green technologies.

The bill also: Authorizes funding and technical assistance for established businesses, Establishes an "Angel Investor" tax credit and allows such investing companies to be eligible for them, Addresses workforce shortage by providing tax credits for businesses hiring new employees, and Establishes a task force on government efficiency to eliminate waste. Although the act authorizes several new tax credits, it sunsets those for (1) donating computers to public and private schools, (2) constructing new facilities housing financial institutions, and (3) paying Small Business Administration guaranty fees. It repeals these credits for income years beginning on or after January 1, 2014.

The legislation creates new ways to attract private capital to investment / venture capital start ups.

**Final Outcome:** The bill was overwhelmingly passed by the House and Senate and was immediately transmitted to the Governor for her signature into law rather than following the usual timeline of bills before they are received by the Governor's office.



## **PASSED**

**House Bill 5498:** An Act Concerning State Contracts for Micro Businesses, Utility Deposits for Connecticut Businesses, the Set Aside of Department of Transportation Contracts for Small Businesses, Grants for Regional Revolving Loan Programs for Microenterprises, and the Issuance of Eligibility Certificates for Certain Economic Development Programs

The legislation attempts to help small businesses by mandating the state to consider a business's annual gross revenues when deciding pre-qualification to be a state contractor; requires the Department of Public Utility Control (DPUC) to study utilities' use of service deposits from nonresidential customers and opens the microloan program to regional revolving loan funds.

**Final Outcome:** The bill was passed by both chambers without any opposition. It was finally signed into law by Governor Rell in June.



## **PASSED**

### **House Bill 5500:** An Act Concerning the Office of Small Business Affairs and Establishing the Small Business Advisory Board

To better assist small businesses in Connecticut, House Bill 5500 requires the state to establish a Small Business Advisory Board to catalogue the resources available to small businesses in the state. The bill also requires the Small Business Affairs

Office to be a point of contact for small businesses seeking assistance, coordinating the small business revolving loan funds and establish a webpage with small business resources.

Streamlining and establishing clearer channels of resources and communication will aid small businesses growth in the state.

The legislation brings attention to the plight of small business in Connecticut.

**Final Outcome:** The bill was passed by the House and sent to the Senate where it was placed on the “consent calendar” and passed unanimously without requiring a roll call vote. The bill was later signed into law by the Governor.



## **DIED Prior to Floor Votes 2010**

### **Senate Bill 63: An Act Mandating Employers to Provide Paid Sick Leave to Employees**

The paid sick leave legislation sought to impose on companies employing 50 or more people a mandate to provide one hour paid time off for every 40 hours that an employee worked. The bill was seen as too costly for businesses in the current economic climate.

An enormous cost mandate on small and medium businesses. This bill would not only cause burdensome increased costs on business but cause slowing of expansion and job growth.

**Final Outcome:** The bill was favorably reported out of the Labor Committee and Appropriations Committee however never reached a floor vote in either chamber.

Considered to be a very anti-business piece of legislation, it faced a great deal of opposition from the business community.



## **DIED Prior to Floor Votes 2010**

### **Senate Bill 485: An Act Concerning Tax Fairness**

If passed this legislation would have changed the current methods of corporate income tax to a “unitary tax” or combined reporting method. A company that is a member of a corporate group of related companies meeting certain criteria and subject to the Connecticut corporation tax would have to determine its Connecticut corporation tax liability based on the net income or capital base of the entire group.

There was concern by some that this new method of reporting may have lead to an imbalance in businesses where some may have either ended up paying too much or too little. It is considered to be an uncertain, costly and complex method of reporting.

The bill would have destroyed in-state corporate and state relationships and set up an intra-state fight over tax policy disadvantaging Connecticut business.

**Final Outcome:** Though favorably reported out of the Finance Revenue and Bonding Committee, the bill “died” on the Senate calendar. It was never called for floor debate or vote by either the House or the Senate.

The final vote of the Finance Revenue and Bonding Committee was along party lines, with the Republican members voting heavily against it.



## **2009 Bills VETOED**

### **House Bill 6582:** An Act Establishing the Connecticut Healthcare Partnership

Also referred to as the “pooling” bill, this legislation would have opened the state health insurance plan to municipal employees, small businesses and non-profits to join voluntarily and required the comptroller to convert the state employee health insurance plan to a self-insured arrangement for benefit periods beginning July 1, 2009 and later.

Similar to House Bill 6600 the outcome of the legislation, had it passed, would have proven potentially negative for businesses. There was little confidence that the state would be able to control costs for healthcare.

Both House Bill 6600 and 6582 were feared to be moving Connecticut one step closer to a universally run healthcare system which would not achieve real healthcare reform. It would carry similar increases of the financial burden for the state and the private sector as HB 6600.

**Final Outcome:** Vetoed by Governor Rell, the legislature failed at their attempt to override her veto during the July 2009 special session.



## **2010 Bills VETOED**

### **Senate Bill 1:** An Act Concerning the Preservation and Creation of Jobs in Connecticut

Though certain sections of the bill were seen as positive, for instance the waiving of the Business Entity Tax for two years for certain small businesses, there were other sections included that would have carried a negative impact and were seen as penalizing existing Connecticut business operations.

The most controversial portion of the bill included the imposition of a surcharge to be placed on employee bonuses received from the Troubled Asset Relief Program (TARP) in the amount of \$500,000 or more. It was viewed by the business community as having the potential to set a dangerous precedent. Governor Rell also expressed her concern over the constitutionality of the tax.

**Final Outcome:** Though passed by both chambers, the bill was vetoed by Governor Rell. During a subsequent “veto session” of the legislature, a veto override was not attempted.
